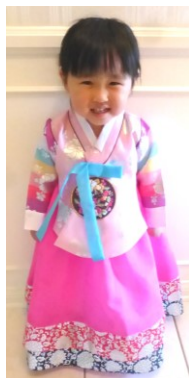
Jin: I turned 40 this year, and 20 years have passed since baptism. I am not YOUNG any more. ^^ I want to make every day worth it in Christ.
